## ORDINANCE NO. 1-2006

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF TIMNATH  
BOARD OF TRUSTEES INITIATING THE  
ADOPTION OF A HOME RULE CHARTER FOR  
THE TOWN OF TIMNATH AND PROVIDING FOR  
THE ELECTION OF CHARTER COMMISSION  
MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the Municipal Home Rule Act of 1971, C.R.S. 31-2-201, et seq., as amended, authorizes the Town of Timnath Board of Trustees to initiate, by ordinance, the adoption of a home rule charter for the Town of Timnath; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Timnath Board of Trustees desires to initiate the adoption of a home rule charter for the Town of Timnath.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF TIMNATH, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. INITIATION OF HOME RULE. That the following question be submitted to a vote of the registered electors of the Town of Timnath, in accordance with the provisions of Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and Municipal Home Rule Act of 1971, at the regular election to be held on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2006;

Shall the Town of Timnath form a home rule charter commission?


Section 2. COMMISSION MEMBERS. That at such election, the registered electors shall also elect a total of nine (9) members to the charter commission to be elected at-large, to take office if the formation of the charter commission is approved by the qualified electors.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one or part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
