# A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONTRACT WITH POLARIZED WATER SOLUTIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE 2025 TIMNATH RESERVOIR NON-POTABLE SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Timnath ("Town") pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-15-103, has the power to pass resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the Town completed an IFB solicitation for construction of the Timnath Reservoir Non-Potable System Improvements and recommends award to Polarized Water Solutions; and

**WHEREAS**, attached hereto as **Exhibit A** contains the bid and scope of work for the Timnath Reservoir Non Potable System Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost exceeds the budget for this project, but there is sufficient funds appropriated to the Capital Improvement Fund generally to cover the cost of this Project, and the Town will pass an ordinance increasing the appropriation for the Capital Improvement Fund if needed for all budgeted projects at a subsequent time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council is familiar with the Project and Agreement and finds it to be in the best interest of the Town, its residents, and the general public to proceed with construction.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TIMNATH, COLORADO AS FOLLOW:

#### Section 1. Approval

The required purchase proposal and expenditure of funds up to \$531,850 for the 2025 Timnath Reservoir Non-Potable System Improvements project, subject to technical or otherwise non-substantive modifications, as deemed necessary by the Town Manager in consultation with the Parks and Recreation Director, Legal Counsel, and other applicable staff or consultant is hereby approved, authorized, and ratified for the construction of the Non-potable system improvements. The required agreements may be finalized by the Town Manager, in consultation with the Parks and Recreation Director, Legal Counsel, and other applicable staff or consultant. Any actions taken prior to the execution of this Resolution, that are within the authority conferred hereby, are ratified, confirmed, and approved by the Town Council.


