

**TOWN OF TIMNATH, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 22, SERIES 2025**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE TOWN MAYOR AND
COUNCILMEMBERS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Timnath (the “Town”) is a home rule municipality operating under the Timnath Home Rule Charter (the “Charter”) adopted on November 7, 2006, as amended from time to time, and the Town’s Municipal Code (the “Code”). Pursuant to the Charter, the Code and the authority given home rule municipalities under Colorado law, the Town may adopt and amend ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to authorize that an annual salary be paid to the Town Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem, and other Councilmembers, to commence after election or re-election of such Councilmembers, as compensation for the many hours devoted to the positions; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 2.11 of the Charter provides “The Mayor and Councilmembers shall receive such compensation as the Council shall by ordinance prescribe; provided, however, no increase or decrease in the compensation of any member of the Council shall take effect during his or her present term of office...”; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that this Ordinance is promulgated under the general police power of the Town, that it is promulgated for the preservation of public health, welfare, peace, safety and property and that this Ordinance is necessary for the protection of public convenience and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TIMNATH, COLORADO,
ORDAINS:**

ARTICLE 1 - The Town Council hereby approves the payment to Councilmembers of the following annual salaries, within the constraints of the annual budget and appropriation ordinance:

Mayor	\$2,600 per year
Mayor Pro Tem	\$2,200 per year
Other Councilmembers	\$2,100 per year.

These salaries shall be paid via equal monthly payments, subject to legally authorized deductions.

The salaries shall not be paid to the sitting Councilmembers for their current term but will be paid beginning on May 1, 2026 for any Councilmember elected or re-elected as Mayor, Mayor Pro Tem or other Councilmember after the date hereof, including those elected in April 2026, November 2028 or thereafter. Nothing herein shall limit the Council’s ability to authorize payment of such necessary bona fide expenses incurred in service on behalf of the Town as are authorized by the Council, in addition to the salary.

All payments authorized herein are subject to annual budget and appropriation.

ARTICLE 2 – SEVERABILITY

If any part or provision of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, is adjudged to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such part, provision, or application shall not affect any of the remaining parts, provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision, part or application, and to this end the provisions and parts of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.


ARTICLE 3 – EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption at second reading, as provided by Section 3.5.5 of the Charter.
