

TOWN OF TIMNATH, COLORADO
RESOLUTION APPOINTING A DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL FOR
THE APRIL 7, 2026 ELECTION
RESOLUTION NO. 14, SERIES 2026

WHEREAS, the Town of Timnath (the “**Town**”) is a home rule municipality operating under the Timnath Home Rule Charter (the “**Charter**”) adopted on November 7, 2006, as amended on November 3, 2015 and April 5, 2022, November 8, 2022 and June 27, 2023, and the Town’s Municipal code (the “**Code**”); and

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council (the “**Council**”) have been duly elected and qualified; and

WHEREAS, a regular election is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Town previously appointed the Town Clerk as the Designated Election Official (the “**DEO**”) on February 27, 2026, Ordinance No. 1, Series 2026. However, since such time, the prior Town Clerk has left the position, and the Town must appoint an additional individual to serve as DEO; and

WHEREAS, the Council has authority to appoint the Deputy Town Clerk as DEO to exercise the authority of the Town and Council in conducting the election; and

WHEREAS, the Council can also appoint a deputy DEO to act in the absence of the DEO or if that individual is unable to exercise the necessary duties in conducting the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TIMNATH, COLORADO AS FOLLOW:

Section 1. Designation of DEO and Deputy DEO.

The Council hereby names Deputy Town Clerk Lizzie Alipaz to serve as the DEO, along with any Town Clerk hired hereafter, and names Katrin Elsholz as the Deputy DEO to conduct the regular election scheduled for April 7, 2026.

Section 2. Severability.

If any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, subsection, paragraph, clause, or provision shall in no manner affect any remaining provisions of his Resolution, the intent being that the same are severable.

Section 3. Effective Date


This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
