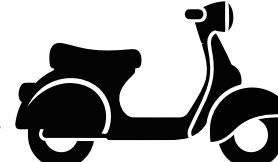


WHICH WHEELS GO WHERE?

		ROADWAYS The portion of street used for vehicle travel.	BIKE LANES A striped/signed lane on the street designated for bicycles or other authorized devices	SIDEWALKS Paved walkways along streets	TRAILS A paved or unpaved path intended for walking, biking or recreation as posted.	WITHIN PARKS, RESERVOIR AND OPEN SPACES (PARKING LOTS, BIKE LANES, SIDEWALKS, ETC.)
BIKES A pedal-powered bike with two or three wheels (human-powered; not motorized). 		Allowed		Allowed		Allowed
E-BIKES - CLASS 1 & 2 Class 1: Pedal-assist only and stops assisting at 20 mph. Class 2: Throttle-assisted and with a top speed of 20 mph. (Has a motor that doesn’t exceed 750 watts and a classification sticker) 		Allowed		Allowed		Allowed
E-BIKES - CLASS 3 Pedal-assisted or throttle-optional stops assisting at 28 mph. (Has a motor that doesn’t exceed 750 watts and a classification sticker) 		Allowed		Allowed		Not Allowed
E-SCOOTERS A stand-up electric scooter with handlebars, under 100 pounds and a 20-mph top speed. 		Allowed		Allowed		Allowed
HUMAN POWERED DEVICES A non-motorized device moved only by the rider. Such as a skateboards & roller skates. 		Allowed (Roads 25 MPH or under)		Allowed (Roads 25 MPH or under)		Allowed
*TOY VEHICLES & OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES A motorized toy or vehicle not designed or approved for roadway use, including recreational or off-highway devices, and not permitted on public property. Such as a dirt bikes, go-peds and kamikaze boards. 		Not Allowed		Not Allowed		Not Allowed
ROADWAY VEHICLES Vehicles that must be registered with the Colorado Department of Motor Vehicles and carry valid insurance to operate on public roads, including low-power scooters and motorcycles. 		Allowed		Not Allowed		Not Allowed

All Wheeled devices must dismount in designated areas and are prohibited from grass, playgrounds, splash pads, etc.
***Exceptions for Toy Vehicles/Off-Highway Vehicles include Kids Ride-on Cars with Parental Supervision, Electric Skateboards & OneWheels.**
