



# **Adopt a Street/Trail General Information**

## **Program Information**

The Town of Timnath strives to foster civic pride by partnering with Timnath residents and businesses through the Adopt a Street/Trail Program. The Program encourages residents and businesses to volunteer to help keep Town streets and trails litter-free and aesthetically pleasing for all who live, work, and visit Timnath. The Program operates at the Town's discretion and may be discontinued or modified at any time.

## **Participation Requirements**

- Agree to perform a cleanup at least three times in one calendar year, with an optional fourth cleaning. Cleanings can only be scheduled once per quarter.
- Have all group members identified.
- Review the application packet and program rules and distribute the rules to all participants.
- All participants must sign a Release of Liability Agreement before participating in a cleanup event.
- All volunteers must wear neon safety vests and observe all safety regulations provided by the Town.
- Ensure all participants comply with all Program rules.
- Inform the Town Adopt-A-Street/Trail Coordinator at least one week prior to each cleanup event.
- After the one-year term, the adopting group may be allowed to retain its adoption of the street or trail for as long as the group



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continues to responsibly participate in regularly scheduled route cleanups.

- If an adopting group does not fulfill the terms of the adoption agreement during the first or any subsequent year, the route will be made available for adoption by a new group at the start of the next calendar year.

### **Town Responsibilities**

The Town will provide:

- A container of cleanup supplies available for pickup at **4800 Goodman Street** one to two days prior to the scheduled cleanup event. Supplies include:
  - Large trash bags
  - Safety vests
  - Disposable nitrile gloves
  - Long-handled trash grabbers.
- Coordination with Public Works for the removal and disposal of full trash bags following each cleanup event.
- After one successful cleanup of your adopted street, the Town will erect two Town-owned Adopt a Street/Trail signs, one in each direction of travel, identifying the adopting group. Sign content, timing, and placement are at the Town's discretion and are dependent on various factors, including, but not limited to:
  - Town funding
  - Staffing
  - Availability of adequate right-of-way for sign placement.



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### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### **Q. What happens after we select our clean-up dates?**

**A.** Once the Program Coordinator receives your proposed clean-up dates, they will coordinate with the Town's Public Works team to confirm the dates and arrange for trash bag pickup following each clean-up.

#### **Q. Do we need to return unused supplies?**

**A.** Yes. Please return any remaining supplies, including grabbers and bins, to the Public Works department within the days following your clean-up.

#### **Q. Are there any requirements for proposing new streets to adopt?**

**A.** Yes. New proposed streets must be 1 mile long at minimum, must be within the Town's boundaries, and regularly maintained by the Town, not CDOT, metro districts or HOAs. If you are unsure whether the street/trail you want to propose meets all of the requirements, please submit it to the Program Coordinator.
